Following a highly successful review of the 2018-19 programme, Cambridgeshire Early Years Service is pleased to offer a Continuous Professional Development package of visits throughout the 2019 - 2020 academic year for Newly Qualified Teachers, Recently Qualified Teachers and those New to Teaching in the Early Years Foundation Stage.

The programme of visits has been specifically tailored to the nursery and reception year and to align with key priorities during the autumn 2019 and spring/summer 2020 terms.

School visits will be hosted by our team of experienced Early Years Lead Practitioners working in Ofsted rated Outstanding and Good early years provision across Cambridgeshire.



The focus of visits will include

- Forest School
- Parent partnerships
- Reports to Parents and end of year Transitions
- The Class Teacher and Teaching Assistant role
- Preparations for a new class and a new academic year
- Successful teaching, learning and application of phonics
- Supporting children and families with Special Educational Need and Disability
- Use of starting point data to plan an enabling and challenging learning environment



Each visit will be accompanied by an Early Years Adviser and will include time for networking and individual support.

The cost of the package of visits and additional support from a named Early Years Adviser throughout the year will be £225.
